Godfrey was very active in Coventry Cathedral and Diocese for over 10 years. He chaired the Diocesan Environment Group and the Net Zero Carbon 2030 Steering Group. As Diocesan Environment Officer (DEO) for Coventry Diocese he had speaking engagements about Eco Church in churches, both for the Diocese and for A Rocha UK in the West Midlands. He continues as a Tutor for the Christian Rural and Environment Studies Certificate. From 2004–2014 he lectured at Warwick University on Ecology and Conservation and briefly ran the PGCE Science course for teacher trainees.
